

Chocolate Peanut Clusters

**16 OZ BAR WHITE CHOCOLATE
OR 16 OZ WHITE CHOCOLATE CHIPS
1 TBSP. SHORTENING
16 OZ SPANISH PEANUTS**

Place your chocolate in a glass mixing bowl. Place in microwave on 30 Seconds intervals mixing with rubber spatula well after each interval until chocolate is melted. Stir in shortening until creamy. Be Careful not to burn your chocolate in microwave. Only cook for 30 seconds at a time maximum.

Add Spanish peanuts and drop by spoonful onto parchment paper. Takes about 3-4 hours to set up. Store in an airtight container.

You can use any flavor of chocolate for this dessert, but I would recommend you use REAL CHOCOLATE and not the chocolate bark or imitation chocolate.
