

## *Hum-dings*

**10 OZ. PACKAGE OF MINI MARSHMALLOWS**  
**1 STICK BUTTER (1/2 CUP)**  
**2 CUPS RICE KRISPY CEREAL**  
**1 CUP CHOPPED PECANS**  
**8 OZ. PACK OF CHOPPED DATES**

Put cereal, pecans, and dates into a large bowl.

In a medium saucepan, melt butter and then add marshmallows. Stir constantly over a medium/low heat. Once marshmallows have melted down, use a whisk or slotted spoon and whip mixture until it becomes uniform and looks like glossy candy.

Pour over ingredients in the bowl and stir well. Once it cools, put it out on parchment paper.

Butter your hands and make sure everything is mixed well, then form into balls about the size of a walnut. Roll in powdered sugar and place all of them in a gallon storage bag and shake well to remove excess sugar. Store in an air-tight container. Enjoy, these are wonderful!
